Botanical Garden Dome Gets a Summer Glow Up

(Des Moines, Iowa) July 11, 2024 — Des Moines' East Village will shine brighter on the evening of July 11 when the Greater Des Moines Botanical Garden illuminates its dome with colorful lights for the first time in the nonprofit's history.

Thanks to generous donations to the Botanical Garden, specialty lighting solutions from Musco Lighting have been installed around the dome. Now, they will be turned on the evening of July 11 to draw attention to one of Des Moines' most beloved attractions.

"There have been plenty of times where we've lit the dome from inside," said Kim Perez, President and CEO of the Greater Des Moines Botanical Garden. "But never have we taken bright and bold inspiration from our flowers and plants and put them on the outside of our facility in the form of lights."

The inaugural dome lighting will take place at dusk, as tunes from the Surf Zombies' "<u>Music in the</u> <u>Garden</u>" concert winds down. Guests will give a countdown as the lights go up.

"It may seem like a small thing, but we are excited to see the dome get a colorful glow up," Perez said. "It's another way to denote the Botanical Garden as a point of connection for many, whether it's for education, entertainment, inspiration or relaxation."

Guests can enjoy the Botanical Garden for seasonally longer hours on Tuesdays from 10 a.m.-7 p.m., Wednesday-Friday 10 a.m.-5 p.m. and weekends 9 a.m.-4 p.m. From the outdoor playscape to indoor rare species and a wide variety of classes and events, the Botanical Garden has something for everyone.
